PARISH UPDATE 11/10/2024

Monday, October 11, is Remembrance Day. Just an FYI especially to those who have just arrived here in Canada: Remembrance Day was originally called Armistice Day commemorating the end of World War I. The emphasis of the celebration is not the political or military events that led to the victory in war; rather it is the memory of all the fallen soldiers who gave the ultimate sacrifice. You might have noticed that Canadians wear red poppy flower on the days leading to Remembrance Day. (All of us should do so too especially those who have obtained Canadian citizenship!) It is because poppy flowers represent simultaneously consolation, remembrance, and death. In ancient times, poppies were placed on tombstones to represent eternal sleep. It was observed that when the war ended in 1918 poppies grew abundantly in the battlefields of France where soldiers have fallen. On Remembrance Day, therefore, let us pray for the souls of those who have perished in war. Moreover, being aware that the world is again being threatened by wars in different places, let us pray wholeheartedly for peace..... I look forward to spending stormy winter days in the rectory sipping warm chocolate, glancing at the blizzard from the window, with baroque classical music in the background, and reading a good book while cosily curling on a newly bought recliner sofa. During this second week of the Good Shepherd Campaign, we invite you to visit the Archdiocese's website to watch the video of Archbishop LeGat and our five seminarians.

The cost to support a seminarian is about \$45,000 per year. This includes accommodation and food, tuition, medical insurance and a monthly stipend. For international seminarians, it is also a question of legal fees and transportation to bring him from abroad. At least twice during his studies, we pay for a trip home to see his family.

The cost to bring in an international priest is about \$20,000. This cost includes legal fees, travel, two and a half months' salary paid by the Archdiocese during his enculturation, language classes if needed, and an allowance for him to stock up on supplies for his first winter here.

We invite you to discern in prayer to support the Good Shepherd Campaign 2024, because priests play a vital role in the Life of the Church. It is important that we continue to support international seminarians and priests in their vocations.

We invite you to pray for our seminarians as they continue to discern God's will in their lives and their journey toward the priesthood.
