Please know that unless the collectors forget to put the Mass collection in the donation box, I do not touch it. It's the third week of the month, so the Mass on Thursday, November 21, will be at 10 AM as I will be attending Catholic Men's Night at Manitou in the evening..... In fact, on that same day that we had our mass wedding of 5 couples here in our parish, my bishop in the Philippines also officiated at our cathedral a mass wedding of 49 couples! I thank John & RV Catibog of the Parish Commission on Family & Life for orchestrating the involvement of talents in the community towards a beautiful and meaningful mass wedding celebration. I thank them also for graciously providing inputs to the news outlets about the community activity as the first request for interview came at a time when I lost my voice to laryngitis.
