We would like to welcome Fr. Eider Agosto Ortiz Tamayo and Bro. Thomas Novak OMI to our parish as they meet and celebrate the Holy Eucharist with the Spanish-speaking Catholic faithful in our area, most of whom are seasonal farm workers. The Holy Mass will be at 7 PM today, August 18. Bro. Thomas is an Oblate brother who coordinates with Fr. Agosto in looking after the spiritual welfare of Spanish-speaking temporary farm workers. He is assisted by members of the Nuestra Señora de la Asuncion Hispanic parish in Winnipeg who provides the singing during the liturgy. We also welcome them as well..... We are so grateful to our temporary farm workers for the produce that we get to enjoy on our tables. We know that working on the farms is hard and difficult toil. Being away from their families to do this work is such a huge sacrifice. And because of the language problem, they cannot even interact with the locals. We are, therefore, very glad to provide them with a venue and an opportunity so that they can worship together in their own language, have a bit a relaxation and fellowship. I encourage all parishioners who know how to speak Spanish to come, pray, and meet with them I wish everyone to have a great time during the Morden Corn and Apple Festival! My best wishes especially go to all volunteers of our parish hamburger booth and the bingo booth..... For new members of the community, here's some historical background on the festival found on the website: The festival was first celebrated in 1967 as part of Canada's Centennial Celebration. Corn cobs and apple cider are given for free every year during the festival! During the 1967 festival, 200 cobs of corn were given away and 80 gallons of apple cider was served. The first C&A festival parade occurred in 1975.
