PARISH UPDATE 04/20/2025

Christ is risen! He is truly risen! Happy Easter, my dear parishioners! May the light of the Resurrection strengthens us to rise anew and press forward in the midst of personal and societal turmoil..... The 2nd Sunday of Easter is Divine Mercy Sunday. Our Altar Servers are doing their Novena starting last Good Friday. Very inspiring, right?..... We are invited! The community at St. Patrick Chaplaincy in Manitou is having a special Divine Mercy Sunday celebration. On April 27th at 2 PM at their church at 532 Fuller Ave., Manitou, there will be Eucharistic Adoration while Confessions are being heard simultaneously. At 3 PM is the recitation of the Chaplet and to be followed by the veneration of the 1st class relic of St. Faustina..... From entry 699 of the Diary of St. Faustina, we read of a vision of our Lord revealing to her: “My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the First Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.”..... 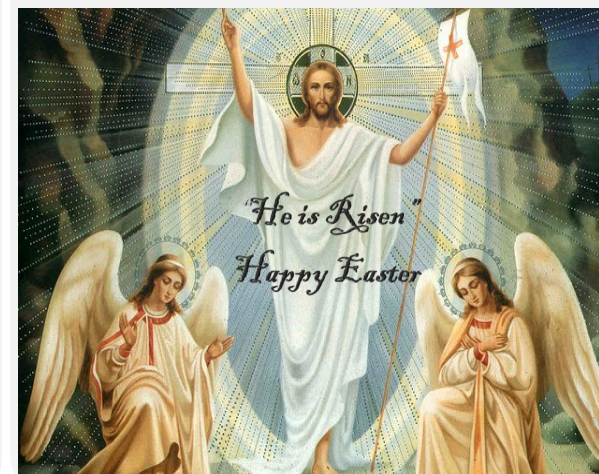
