# PARISH UPDATE 07/21/2024

As baptized Christians, we are united together through a supernatural bond. The Catechism teaches, "Baptism... constitutes the sacramental bond of unity existing among all who through it are reborn" (CCC, 1271). This bond extends even to baptized non-Catholics. But among us Catholics, we foster this bond primarily in the parish community where we belong. This supernatural bond is stronger than the natural bond of blood. And, if we consider our family members special, it is because in addition to being naturally bonded to them by blood, we are supernaturally united to them in Christ......... Our parish community, however, has grown so big that we do not know a lot of the other members or see each other in the church. Others regularly attend the Sunday Vigil Mass on Saturday, while others prefer to attend the Sunday Mass. It is very important, therefore, that we have activities that gather us all together as one family. Such is the rationale of our Parish Feast and Family Day on July 28. This year's celebration is even more special because we will be honouring the senior members of our community who started the building of the church we are currently using, and mostly whose donations and fundraising efforts paid the mortgage off in just 12 years or so. Part of our celebration on Sunday will be the burning of mortgage documents....... I am highly encouraging everyone to participate the Parish Feast & Family Day. We'll start our celebration with Mass at 11 AM at the Minnewasta School grounds. Then, we'll have potluck lunch, tribute to senior members of the parish, entertainment, and games. While, the PPC will provide hamburger and water, I enjoin you to kindly bring food for your family and a little bit more to share with others, picnic chair, plates, glasses and cutlery. The PPC will provide disposable plates, glasses and cutlery. But, we are hoping we don't have to use them as part of our effort to care for the environment.......... Because of the Novena, I will be celebrating Mass at our church on Monday, July 22 at 7 PM. Let us continue praying the Novena in honour of our titular St. John the Evangelist until the 27th of this month:
