Especially to those who usually attend the Sunday Vigil Mass on Saturdays, be reminded again that the **Mass on Saturday, June 29, is at 7 PM** instead of 5 PM. It will be celebrated by Archbishop LeGatt who will also administer Holy Confirmation on some members of our community..... The sign-up sheet for the Corn & Apple Festival is posted. Volunteer with your family or group of friends to sell hamburgers at our parish booth or at Bingo or as camping fee collectors!..... Save the date! Our Parish Family Feast Day will be on July 28, a Sunday. There will be Mass at 11 AM at the Minnewasta school grounds followed by potluck lunch, entertainment, relay games and a sportsfest for the young..... The theme for this year's Parish Family Feast Day is: **CALLED TO SHARE**. It is based on the Gospel of that Sunday which is about the generosity of a little boy giving his 5 loaves and 2 fish, thus allowing Jesus to perform a miracle that fed five thousand men. On this parish feast day, we honor in a special way the "original" parishioners of St. John the Evangelist Parish. Some of them have gone ahead of us to the Father's house, while most are still with us as senior members in our community. They are those who are responsible in fostering community life and built the church building which we are currently using. Like the little boy in the Gospel account of the multiplication of the bread and fishes, they generously sacrificed time, talent and treasure to build a strong foundation of community life and an edifice that made newcomers feel welcome. They were the ones who were called to share and responded to the call without hesitation. So, on the feast day, we will honor them with a tribute capped by the burning of the mortgage which they have paid off through thousands of perogies and hours of volunteering during fundraisers especially during the Corn & Apple Festival..... The same call is being passed on to us who are newly incorporated into the parish community. We are all called to be generous with our respective five loaves and two fishes so that the parish will continue to grow as home for every Catholic that comes to this part of Manitoba. The challenge to improve the church building and its facilities, to make every program and activity successful, to assist each parish member to grow in the faith and in community life is now ours also. 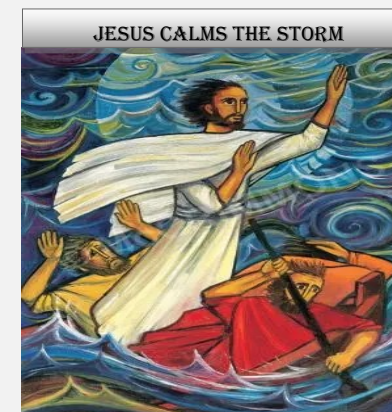
