PARISH UPDATE 04/27/2025

There will be NO MASS from April 28 – May 2. No, I am not joining the Conclave in Rome to elect the new pope. LOL! Rather, I will join Archbishop LeGatt and the other priests of the Archdiocese of St. Boniface on our annual retreat in Pinawa. I humbly ask for your prayers during the entire duration of our retreat..... On Easter Sunday, Pope Francis made his last public appearance to give the Urbi et Orbi (To the City [of Rome] and to the World) Message. The message was read by Archbishop Diego Ravelli, the Master of Pontifical Liturgical celebrations, and subsequently the late pontiff gave the blessing. The following morning, he “returned to the house of the Father”. Since last Tuesday, daily Mass intentions in our parish church include the eternal repose of Pope Francis. A special prayer for his soul is said at the end of every Mass. During the Sunday 11 AM this weekend, as a community, we will pray still for the eternal repose of his soul as well as for the guidance of the College of Cardinals as they enter into the Conclave to elect the next Vicar of Christ on earth..... I encourage all of you to read the entire text online of Pope Francis’ last Urbi et Orbi message. Here is an excerpt:

Dear brothers and sisters,

Happy Easter! Today at last, the singing of the “alleluia” is heard once more in the Church, passing from mouth to mouth, from heart to heart, and this makes the people of God throughout the world shed tears of joy.

From the empty tomb in Jerusalem, we hear unexpected good news: Jesus, who was crucified, “is not here, he has risen” (Lk 24:5). Jesus is not in the tomb, he is alive!

Love has triumphed over hatred, light over darkness and truth over falsehood. Forgiveness has triumphed over revenge. Evil has not disappeared from history; it will remain until the end, but it no longer has the upper hand; it no longer has power over those who accept the grace of this day.

Sisters and brothers, especially those of you experiencing pain and sorrow, your silent cry has been heard and your tears have been counted; not one of them has been lost! In the passion and death of Jesus, God has taken upon himself all the evil in this world and in his infinite mercy has defeated it. He has uprooted the diabolical pride that poisons the human heart and wreaks violence and corruption on every side. The Lamb of God is victorious! That is why, today, we can joyfully cry out: “Christ, my hope, has risen!” (Easter Sequence).

In the Lord’s Paschal Mystery, death and life contended in a stupendous struggle, but the Lord now lives forever (cf. Easter Sequence). He fills us with the certainty that we too are called to share in the life that knows no end, when the clash of arms and the rumble of death will be heard no more. Let us entrust ourselves to him, for he alone can make all things new (cf. Rev. 21:5)!

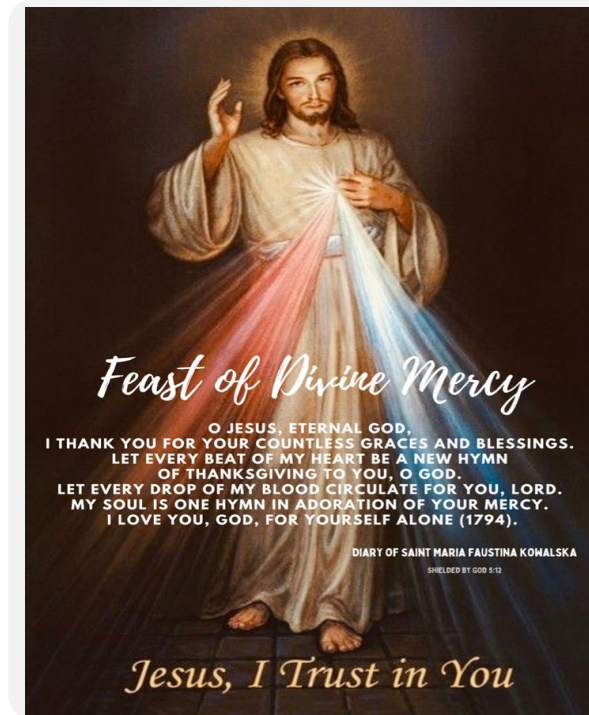
