PARISH UPDATE 10/27/2024

Saturday, November 2, is All Souls Day. Aside from the regular 5 PM Mass, which is a vigil Mass for Sunday, there will be another Mass at 11 AM just for our deceased loved ones. You are invited to come and bring the list of names of your departed family members, friends and relatives. Note well, unlike the 5 PM Mass, the morning Mass does not fulfill your Sunday obligation. After the Mass, I will proceed to Hillside Cemetery to bless the graves of deceased parishioners. You are all invited to that as well..... Our thanks the children and their parents for participating in our All Saints Day cosplay! May the saints always guide, protect, and always intercede for your respective families. Our thanks also to our hardworking catechists for initiating and planning the event!..... I would like to share to you a couple of significant universal Church news: a new Canadian saint and a new encyclical from Pope Francis!..... Last Sunday, October 20, Pope Francis elevated to sainthood St. Marie-Leonie Paradis. She was born in 1840 in L'Acadie, Quebec. She's the third of six children. At a very young age of 14, she joined the Marianite Sisters of Holy Cross and spent decades of teaching and serving across the U.S. and Canada. She felt God calling her to found a separate religious congregation. So, in 1877, she founded the Little Sisters of the Holy Family whose original charism is to support young girls living in poverty. She died on May 3, 1912 due to cancer. A miracle involving the cure of a baby girl born prematurely in 1986 with multi-organ failure and encephalopathy lead to her canonization. That baby girl is now a healthy grown up, and is now a language teacher..... Last Thursday, October 24, Pope Francis released his encyclical titled Dilexit Nos (He Loved Us) which is dedicated to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. In the Letter, the Pontiff laments that in our societies, "we are also seeing a proliferation of varied forms of religiosity that have nothing to do with a personal relationship with the God of love." Christians, meanwhile, often forgets "the tender consolations of faith, the joy of serving others, the fervour of personal commitment to mission." In response to this situation, the Holy Father calls for a renewal of "authentic devotion" to the Sacred Heart. After all, it is in the Heart of Jesus that "we find the whole Gospel". It is in His Heart that "we truly come at last to know ourselves and we learn to love". An authentic devotion to the Sacred will make us "capable of forging bonds of fraternity, of recognizing the dignity of each human being, and of working together to care for our common home." I encourage everyone to read the entire encyclical letter.
