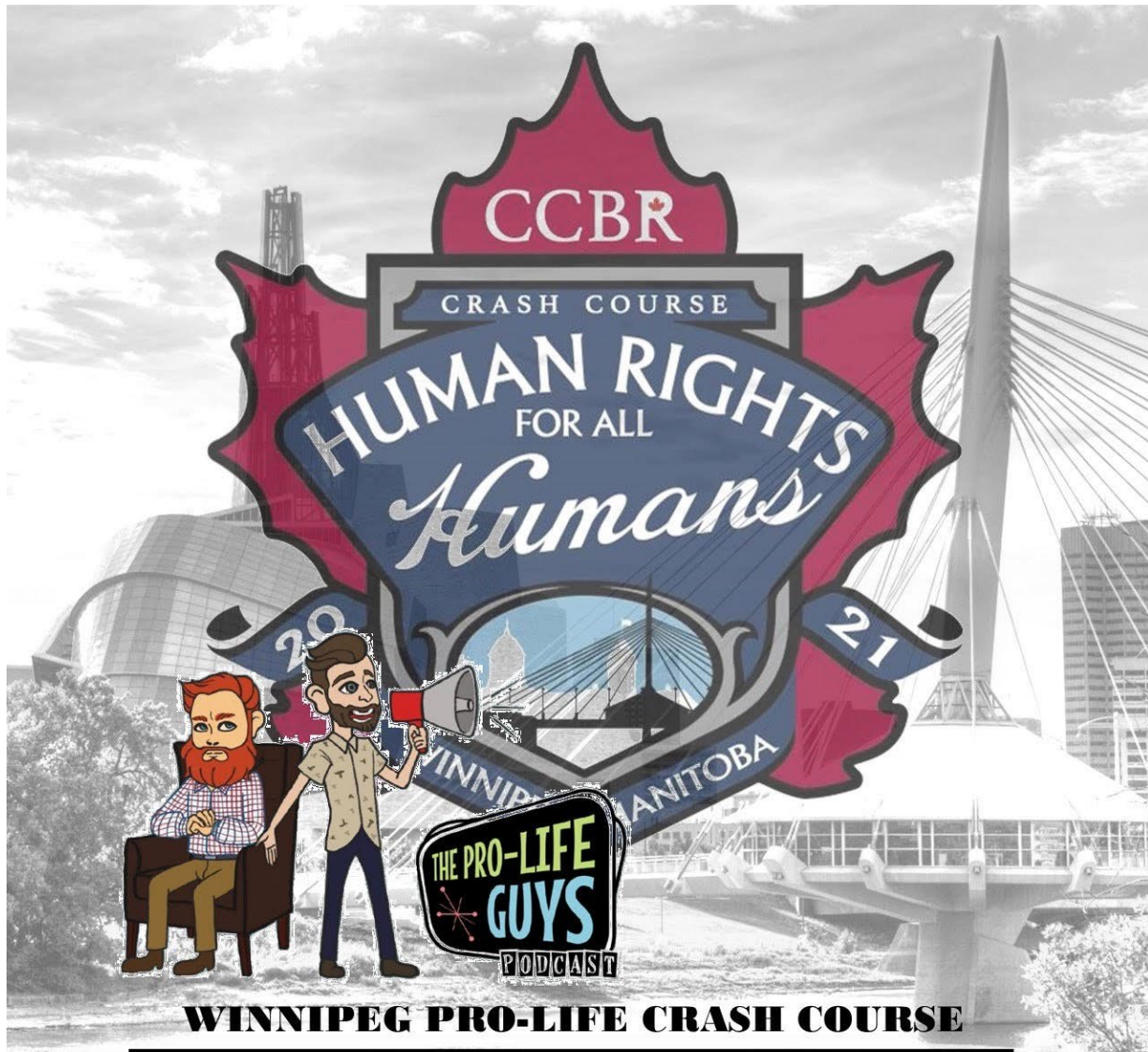


THE SHEPHERDS WALKING STICK
