#### **PARISH UPDATE 08/14/2022 -**

Tomorrow, August 15, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of Our Lady. Usually I celebrate Mass on Mondays sine populo (without the people). But, since it is such an important feast and many of you might be desiring to attend Mass, I will be celebrating the Holy Eucharist at 8 o'clock in the morning before I leave town to enjoy a day off..... The dogma of the Assumption was formally declared by Pope Pius XII in 1950. Of course, the belief that the Blessed Mother after her life on earth was taken up to heaven body and soul can be traced back to the first century disciples and handed down through the centuries by Sacred Tradition. The dogma of the Assumption does not define how, when or where the Assumption took place, only the fact that Our Lady was taken up to the glory of heaven, body and soul..... I think it is remarkable that the solemnity of the Assumption falls at this time of summer when the gardens and fields are almost ripe for harvesting. It directs our eyes to the harvest at the end of the world wherein we hope to be gathered together into the kingdom of God. The writer Pius Parsch comments, "[T]he Church celebrates the most glorious 'harvest festival' in the Communion of Saints. Mary, the supremely blessed one among women, Mary, the most precious fruit which has ripened in the fields of God's kingdom, is today taken into the granary of heaven.".....
