As of writing, the Corn & Apple Festival is yet to happen.

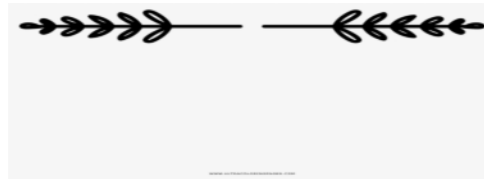
However, in behalf of the entire parish community,
