PARISH UPDATE 12/26/2021

The restriction changes are usually effective with barely a time for us to make adjustments. It is not a surprise, therefore, that some of you might be wondering if our parish church is observing those restrictions. We always look to the Archdiocesan Center for clarifications which on the latest restriction change said: “Indoor faith-based gatherings are now limited to 25 per cent capacity or 25 people, whichever is lesser. . . . Please note that this restriction may be increased to 25% of the capacity of the space, to a maximum of two hundred and fifty (250) people, by separating attendees into cohorts. Fully separated parts of the church building (e.g., worship space and parish hall, choir lofts or wings that may be accessed from different entrances) may be used for different groupings of twenty-five (25) people each, with each grouping having its own entrance and exit.” In our church, the east side pews is one cohort, the west side pews is another. Another group of 25 may be accommodated in the parish hall where there is a separate access through the kitchen. The faithful must wait for the minister to approach each cohort during communion to prevent comingling. The west side cohort exits first as soon as the recessional is sung. There will be volunteers to do the disinfecting after the celebration. My heartfelt gratitude to the Couples for Christ (CFC) for managing the cohorts, the contact tracing list and disinfection.
