Parish update Feb 6, 2022

The donation receipts are ready for pick up at the church lobby..... In behalf of the Parish Finance Council, I would like to thank everyone for your generosity in supporting the parish. Be assured that even if most of you cannot come for the liturgy, you have been nourished spiritually by it through the bond of Baptism that we all share. That's what the communion of saints is all about..... At this point, I would like also to encourage those who are relatively new in the parish - the Catholic immigrants - to step up in supporting the parish. The original members of the parish made great sacrifices to build a beautiful church building. We should try our best to own it by supporting for its upkeep by giving at least a minimum.....

How can one determine the minimum to give to the church? Well, the easiest is to give 1 dollar a day for the Lord for each Catholic family. That means 365 dollars every year. 1 dollar for each day for each family, that's even less than a cup of coffee at Tim Horton's. Another way of determining the minimum is to add the ages of all the Catholic members in the household. For example, if the combined age of the parents is 80 and the children is 24, so the minimum donation for the year would be 104 dollars.....May I remind you that a percentage of your donation is re to you by way of tax refund..... You may request the parish office for donation envelopes or you may donate through e-transfer.
