PARISH UPDATE 07/17/2022 –

would like to reiterate my request for volunteers to become parish Catechists. There are no special qualifications, just the availability, the fondness for young people, and the eagerness to share the faith. The good thing, I observed in the Church here in the Canada, is that there is no lack of resources – manuals, books, digital media - with regards to imparting the faith. So, it's just a matter of putting these resources to use..... Also, I would like to repeat the invitation to participate in our Parish Family Day celebration next Sunday, July 24. It's a three-phase celebration starting with the 11 AM outdoor Mass (weather permitting). Agape lunch follows. You may bring potluck to share, but there will be hamburgers and hotdogs for everyone. Kindly sign-up so that we can estimate how much stuff to buy..... July 24 is also the 2nd World Day for Grandparents & the Elderly. So, indeed our parish celebration is very coincidental. Pope Francis established the universal celebration last year and to be celebrated every closest Sunday to the feast of Sts. Joachim and Anne (July 26). The theme for this year is: IN OLD AGE THEY WILL STILL BEAR FRUIT. The theme “intends to emphasize how grandparents and the elderly are a value and a gift both for society and for ecclesial communities,” said the communique from the Dicastery for Laity, the Family and Life..... Very importantly, I would like to call your attention to the plenary indulgence is available to everyone who attends Mass or other prayer services on the occasion of World Day for Grandparents & the Elderly. The indulgence can also be applied as a suffrage for the souls in purgatory. To receive the plenary indulgence, which is a full remission of the temporal punishment due for one's sins, a person must: (a) show detachment from sin, (b) go to confession, (c) receive the Eucharist and (d) pray for the intentions of the pope. The indulgence also is available to “the elderly sick and all those who, unable to leave their homes for a serious reason, spiritually join” the celebrations, particularly by watching

on television or the internet or listening on the radio, and “offer to the merciful God their prayers, sorrows and sufferings,” the Vatican said.....
