At the end of the Mass on that same Sunday, there will be a procession of the Blessed Sacrament starting from the church exiting through the north door traversing the Minniwasta School driveway to St. John St going to church parking lot where the procession will end with a solemn Benediction..... There will be Children's Rosary on June 14 (Tuesday) at 7 PM. I invite the parents to bring their children closer to our Lady through this activity..... CONSECRATION OF THE FAMILY TO THE SACRED HEART
