will end the liturgical calendar with the Solemnity of Christ the King. This solemnity was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man's thinking and living and organizes his life as if God did not exist. Therefore, it is more imperative than ever to give importance to this celebration. The solemnity on Sunday is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ's royalty over individuals families, society, governments, and nations.....

On Sunday, at the end of the Mass, there will be a procession of the Blessed Sacrament inside the church. It will be followed by the Benediction.....

Do you know that this year is the 10th year since the community has been using the current church building? The first time the community celebrated Mass in the church was on November 19, 2011!

Mass Booking

Due to COVID protocols, you are required to sign-up for Mass on either Saturday at 5:00 pm, Sunday at 11:00 am, or Sunday at 7:00 pm. Each individual/family member must sign-up. For example, if you are signing up yourself, your spouse, and two children...you will need four different sign-ups.

When signing up, please follow these protocols:

- a) signing-up means that one is not aware that s/he is suffering from any covid-like symptoms.
- b) signing-up means s/he has not been out of the province for the last 14 days.
- c) contact details will not be shared to other entities except to public health officials and only ***if there is suspicion of covid exposure.***
