PARISH UPDATE 10/31/2021 - Last October 28 (Thursday), I was very much pleased to welcome Henjie San Juan, Couples for Christ (CFC) Canada National Director, Ronnie Licsi, CFC Winnipeg Area Director, and company to our parish. Over an informal meeting, we discussed some areas of parish life where the CFC can assist us in terms of fostering growth through various activities..... On Tuesday, November 2, is All Souls Day. In the morning, I will go to the Morden Hillside Cemetery and bless the graves of parish members who have gone before us to eternity.....The Mass for our deceased relatives and friends on All Souls Day will be at 7 PM. Since most of you who have immigrated here cannot visit the resting places of your deceased loved ones, we will make a temporary monument for them in front of the altar. I encourage you to come to Mass on this day bringing with you the list of names of your beloved dead. We will mention and pray for each one during the Prayers of the Faithful, after which we will put the lists inside the monument which will be blessed also towards the end of the Mass..... I encourage you all to offer Mass for your beloved dead especially during this month of November and also during their anniversaries. Now, you may ask: If one Mass has infinite value, why do we need to offer Mass continually for our beloved dead? Indeed, just one Mass is enough to empty Purgatory! However, while a Mass is of infinite value, the souls of the faithful are limited in their receptiveness to receive the satisfactory power of the Mass. It's like trying to drink from a river with a small cup. To be satisfied of your thirst, your cup must be filled again and again. In the same manner, we need to offer prayers and especially the Mass for poor souls. By this way they are brought step by step closer to the heavenly reward. Requiem aeternam dona eis Domine! Et lux perpetua luceat eis!
