I would like to congratulate as well the parents of these children for preparing their children to receive the Sacraments of Penance and the Holy Eucharist..... I would like to remind all parents, however, that your mission does not end with First Communion or Confirmation. Nor is it sporadic. A verse from Deuteronomy (6:6-7) comes to mind: “Take to heart these words which I enjoin on you today. Drill them into your children. Speak of them at home and abroad, whether you are busy or at rest.” Moses uttered these words on his death bed as a final instruction to the Israelites as they are about to take possession of the Promised Land. He meant to say that if the people want the Lord to bless them as they settle in Canaan, they must resist the influence of the pagan cultures around them. They can do that by passing on the teachings of God to their children. In the same manner, Christian parents must continuously reinforce the teachings of the faith on their children, so that they will be equipped to confront the secular culture around us and always be a blessing to the family and to the community. Parents, enrol your children to the parish Catechism program, take every opportunity to follow-up what they are learning. Above all, bring them always to church so that they will learn from you how to value and love the sacraments.
