#### Special Projects

Dear Parishioners:

During the year, we had a few special projects that we Had to undertake, including:

A different organ to replace the current one that is not working. The estimated costs are \$2,000 (Moving the replacement in and moving the old one out, a tune up and the related parts).

A newer lawn mower to replace the old one, with a cost of \$1,100 after we sell the old unit.

A newer barbeque to replace the old unit, which we use for various pot luck and church family events. The old unit's burners had burnt out and heating was limited and slow. Cost \$200

A new computer to replace the old one, electrical components were destroyed during the lightning / thunderstorm in the early hours on Thursday Sep 5, 2019. Likely cost with software is around \$750.

We have installed Mornet equipment for internet connectivity for a cost of \$500. Although we are not yet in an approved area, special entities like business and non-residential organizations can apply for exemption, and ours was approved. We are quickly recovering the money spent, with the monthly internet payments not required.

There are \$4550 in expenes that we would like you to consider for your special project cost donations
