### **Missionaries of Charity** **Food & Winter Clothing Drive**

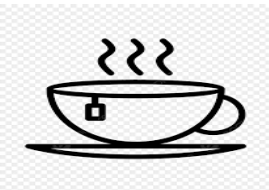
